

Key Stage 2 Test Results (Summer 2011)

Please see below for a summary of our KS2 SATs results. These are significantly improved on the previous year.

Value Added

The government expects that pupils should make one level of progress over two years. This means that the 'average child' should make two levels of progress from Yr2 (when they last had SATs) to the end of Yr6.

Matching achievement to benchmark predictions

At this school we use Cognitive Ability Tests (CATs) when the child enters Yr5. These give us predictions for each child. Another measure of the school's effectiveness is to identify how many pupils meet these predictors.

English	81% met or exceeded their CAT predictions 23% exceeded their CAT predictions
Maths	73% met or exceeded their CAT predictions 14% exceeded their CAT predictions

***NB: This does not hold entry data on all pupils (including attainment at the end of Yr2 and/or CATs data). These percentages are for pupils where we had a complete set of data.*
